REGULATORY CONTEXT

The [EU eIDAS](#) Regulation entered into force on 1st July 2016 throughout the European Union and sets out the rules for electronic identification and trust services for electronic transactions in the internal market.

This regulation facilitates the cross-border recognition of electronic signatures throughout the EU.

It defines 3 levels of electronic signatures: standard, advanced and qualified. It has been transcribed into French law in Articles 1366 and 1367 of the Civil Code. These articles establish the legal value of the electronic signature in France.

With a few rare exceptions related to family or personal matters, all documents can be signed electronically in France.
